Re: Withdrawal of Relocation and Expansion Proposal

Dear Expansion Committee:

We received your letter dated October 14, 2021, wherein you informed Brickworks of the additional expense involved with the relocation of the Woodbury Township Cemetery. To confirm, it is our understanding that the mandatory involvement of the Iowa Office of State Archeologist during the relocation process would increase the cost of the project by at least \$2,500,000 due to their jurisdiction over approximately 900 burial sites.


Based on this new information, Brickworks is withdrawing its offer to pay for the relocation of the Woodbury Township Cemetery.

In the coming months, Brickworks will be engaging in discussions with the City of Sergeant Bluff to create a partnership where together we will look at building a new road into the Woodbury Township Cemetery that will create safer access for the public to the Cemetery. If we are able to build this new road, the City and Brickworks will then work together to vacate the existing Cemetery Road and, in exchange, Brickworks will deed approximately 10 acres of its property North of South Ridge Road to the City so that the City can build a new cemetery.

We believe that providing these 10 acres to the City of Sergeant Bluff will greatly benefit its citizens and we look forward to continuing our long-standing partnership with the City and the community.

We want to thank those that have been part of your committee and efforts they have undertaken to consider our offer.
